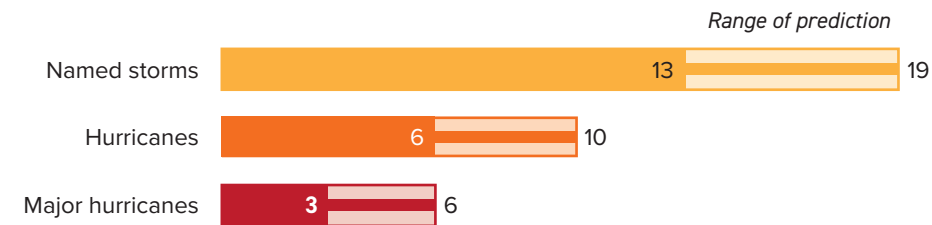

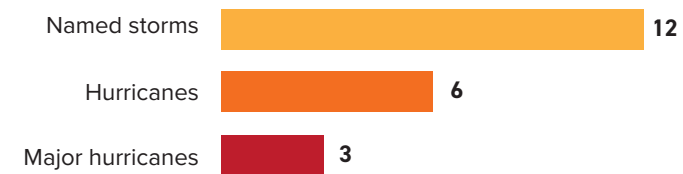
# NOAA forecasts a busy 2020 Atlantic hurricane season

The 2020 hurricane season — from June 1 to Nov. 30 — has a 60 percent chance of being “above-normal,” according to NOAA’s Climate Prediction Center. The Center also forecasts a 30 percent chance of a “near-normal” season and a 10 percent chance of a “below-normal” season.
