

BRAUN AWARD

Nancy L. Munn

E. Lucy Braun was an eminent plant ecologist and the first woman president of the Ecological Society of America. Besides describing and mapping the deciduous forest regions of eastern North America, Lucy Braun served as a dedicated teacher and role model

for her students. To honor her, this award is presented to a student (undergraduate, graduate or recent doctorate) for the outstanding poster presentation at the Society's annual meeting.

The winner of the first Braun Award is Nan-

cy L. Munn for her poster presentation, "Substrate-specific nutrient uptake in two small streams: an intersite comparison." Nancy both completed her undergraduate studies and received a master's degree from the University of Alberta and is currently completing her doctorate at the University of Georgia.

Receiving an honorable mention citation was G. I. Fryer of the University of Calgary for her poster, "Determination of fire behavior and effects for a historical fire in the Canadian Rockies." It is noteworthy that Ms. Fryer was an undergraduate student at the time this research was completed.
