
E. LUCY BRAUN AWARD

E. Lucy Braun was an eminent plant ecologist and the first woman president of the Ecological Society of America. Besides describing and mapping the deciduous forest regions of eastern North America, Lucy Braun served as a dedicated teacher and role model to her students. To honor her, this award is presented to a student for the outstanding poster presentation at the Society's Annual Meeting.

The 1995 winner of the E. Lucy Braun Award is Stephen M. Ogle for his poster "Exotic plant invasion and ecosystem features at Wind Cave National Park in South Dakota," based on his master's thesis at the University of Wyoming under the supervision of William A. Reiners. Stephen received his bachelor's degree at Emory University. He is currently a doctoral student at the University of Wyoming.

Receiving an honorable mention citation is Mark D. Bowen of Utah State University for his poster "Microhabitat position preference and tests of four habitat use models for stream-dwelling salmonids under two disturbance regimes."
