## **E. LUCY BRAUN AWARD**

E. Lucy Braun was an eminent plant ecologist and the first woman president of the Ecological Society of America. Besides describing and mapping the deciduous forest regions of eastern North America, Lucy Braun served as a dedicated teacher and role model to her students. To honor her, this award is presented to a student for the outstanding poster presentation at the Society's annual meeting.

The 1997 winner of the E. Lucy Braun Award is Caren C. Dymond for her poster "Subalpine community composition change along topographically modelled resource gradients in a South-Eastern Canadian Rockies watershed," based on her current master's degree research at the University of Calgary under the supervision of Edward Johnson. Caren also received her bachelor's degree from the University of Calgary.
