
BUELL AWARD

Stephen R. Palumbi

Stephen R. Palumbi of the University of Washington was the 1984 recipient of the Murray F. Buell Award. Dr. Palumbi is currently with the Departments of Zoology and Biochemistry, University of California, Berkeley. Next year he will join the faculty of the Department of Zoology, University of Hawaii.

Murray Buell ascribed great importance to the participation of students in meetings and to excellence in the presentation of papers. To honor Murray Buell's dedication to the Ecological Society of America and to the younger generation of ecologists, this award is presented to a student (undergraduate, graduate or recent doctorate) for an outstanding paper presented at the Society's annual meeting. The title of Stephen Palumbi's paper at the Colorado State University meetings was: "Evolution of phenotypic plasticity: evidence that the jack of all trades is the master of none."
