

It was learned with regret that T. L. Hankinson, Professor of Zoology at the Michigan State Normal College, Ypsilanti, died on December 3. He was born in Valparaiso, Indiana, in 1876, studied at Michigan State College and Cornell, and for years taught zoology at Eastern Illinois State Normal School at Charleston. From 1919 to 1921 he was ichthyologist in the Roosevelt Wild Life Experiment Station. He was well known as a student of the ecology of fishes. Professor Hankinson was a member of the Ecological Society since its beginning, and vice-president in 1919.
